## History

Founded in 1980, the Group was established by former Conservative MP for Lanark and 17th Earl of Lauderdale, Patrick Francis Maitland, and The Rt Hon. Dr J. Dickson Mabon, former MP for Greenock and Port Glasgow and Labour Minister for Energy from 1976-79. It remains the only Parliamentary Group to cover all areas of the energy sector. Our aim is to advise the Government of the day on the energy issues of the day.

This diversity of expertise is evidenced by the broad range of subjects covered throughout the years by our monthly guest speakers and, more recently, by contributors to *Energy Focus*. Recent topics have included crisis recovery, Mission Zero, and updating our Energy Policy Priorities.

The Parliamentary estate reopened after CoViD during the course of this year and face-to-face meetings were again possible. This year also marked both the Platinum Jubilee of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II and, sadly, the end of her reign.

Full "return to normal" took some months, as soon as face-to-face meetings were permitted, travel was disrupted by strikes. However, we were able to hold our Summer Reception in Jubilee spirit.

Disruption continued, but we were again very fortunate to be able to hold our Annual House of Lords Dinner, which was sponsored by Alfa Energy. Indeed, this had to be postponed from October as the House was closed for Her Majesty Lying in State, so was held at the end of February 2023.

Through all this, PGES aimed to continue to inform the Government of the day on the energy issues of the day.

We have again held speaker meetings this year. Our speakers were still of the highest calibre and the topics focussed on Net Zero, policy and priorities.

We had hoped that remote access to these meetings would be one of the behaviours that continued post CoViD, but the APPG rules prevent this. We also recognise that nothing can replace the face-to-face discussions.

Parliamentary work continues on the fundamental issue of energy. It is even more important now that we focus on our objective of advising the Government of the day on the energy issues of the day. Even if policy matters are delayed by politics, the climate emergency takes no heed. That's why, whatever the future may hold, I am confident that the All-Party Parliamentary Group for Energy Studies, along with its members, will be at the forefront of the policy discussion.

Accounts for the year to 28<sup>th</sup> February 2022 showed an operating deficit of £13,603 for 2022-23. This depleted reserves, leaving £11,776.
